## Limitations:

- Captured material should be represented as it was captured, with appropriate information on mode of harvesting and date.
- To the extent reasonably possible, the legal proprietors of the sites in question should be identified according to the prevailing conventions of attribution.
- Libraries should provide copyright owners with a simple tool for registering objections to making items from such a collection available online, and respond to such objections promptly

**Jonathan Band's Advice**

- 1. Website archiving is routinely done by two of the wealthiest corporations in the world (Google and Microsoft) for commercial purposes.**
  - a. When Google has been sued in the US concerning its website archiving, it has prevailed. If they can archive websites, you certainly can.**
- 2. In the last few months, libraries have prevailed in all the copyright suits brought against them -- Georgia State, HathiTrust, and UCLA.**
  - a. Not only did Georgia State prevail, it also was awarded \$2.8 million in attorneys' fees.**
- 3. I'm not aware of anyone complaining about website archiving by libraries.**
  - a. If a specific rights holder complains, you can always remove his website.**



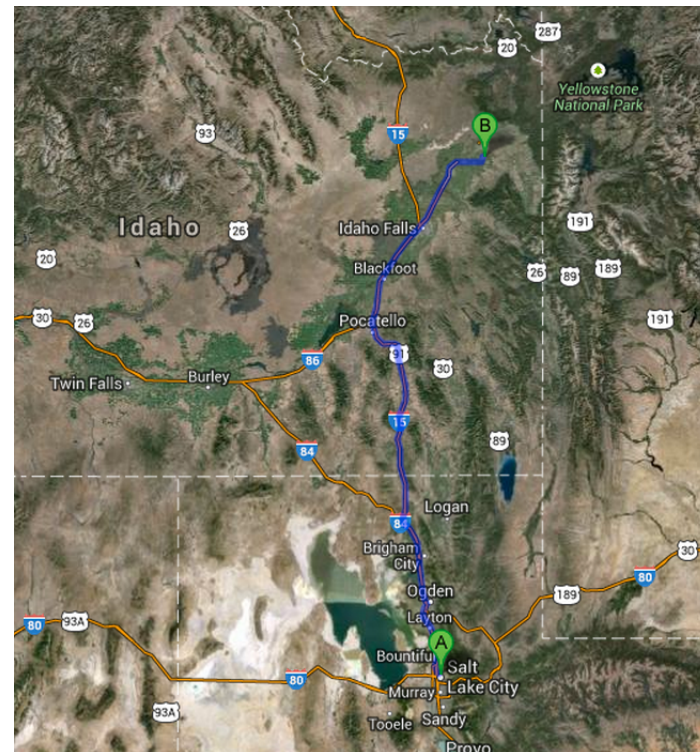

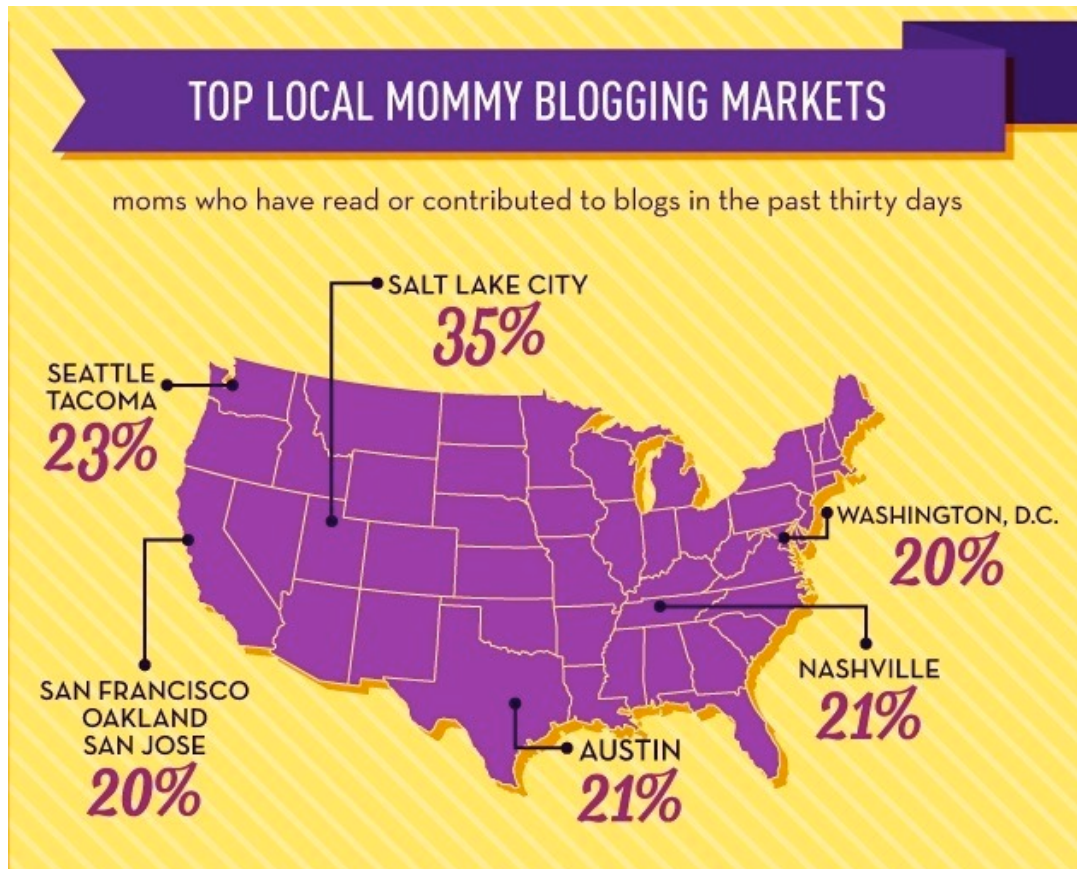
